Year 11 Careers Interviews

Year 11 is a crucial year for so many reasons, but not least because every Year 11 student is guided into serious consideration of his/her post-16 options, and beyond that, potential Career Pathway. Every effort, therefore, is invested to ensure that every Year 11 student will receive at least one 30-minute 'in person' interview with Mr Shori, a Careers and Employability Advisor who works for North Yorkshire Council.

Mr Shori is a Level 6 trained careers adviser with over 15 years of extensive experience in supporting students in their career decision making and raising aspirations.

During the 30-minute 1-1 guidance interview, Mr Shori will help your child to:

- identify personal qualities and skills
- identify the skills the student would like to develop
- come up with ideas for study and work
- explore specific career areas
- explore positive and possible pathways and local labour market
- Support with Applications
- understand the process of job search, writing a CV and going for interviews
- explore interests, likes and dislikes, family influences, personal barriers and work experience
- think about how study, work experience, and home-life can all contribute to employability

Careers interviews will commence next Thursday (10th October), and will take place every Thursday until every Year 11 student has had their interview.

There is a schedule in place for these interviews, and students will be informed next Tuesday morning of the time their interview will be taking place. Students will be also reminded each Thursday morning (just in case they forget!).
