### **NEW YORK CITY TRIP – JULY 2018**

With only 2 weeks to go until we set off on our trip to New York, I just wanted to confirm a few things with you.

**Firstly, please remember to bring your child's passport to school with you on the morning of departure as this is essential for them to travel!**

On the day that we depart for New York, Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July, the bus will be in the school car park from 04:30am ready for students to load their luggage. **We will be leaving Bedale High School at 05:00am sharp** in order to give us plenty of time to travel to Manchester and get through airport clearance in time for the flight. The flight details are as follows:

- Departing – Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2018 at 10.35am Manchester to New York JFK, flight number MT 2852
- Returning – Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2018 08.00pm New York JFK to Manchester, flight number MT 2849.

Please note that times provided are UK timings and therefore we won't arrive back to Bedale High School until around midday on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2018.


Each student has a 22kg luggage limit for their suitcase (hold luggage). The usual restrictions on carrying items on board an aircraft apply. Liquids that are over 100ml must be packed in students hold luggage. Liquids that are under 100ml may be carried in their hand luggage as long as they are in a clear plastic bag. Please ensure that any medication required is carried in your child's hand luggage so that they have it on their person should the need for them to use it arise. It is very important that students pack their own bags and DO NOT carry anything for other people as they could be asked about the contents at check in and security. Also please note that foodstuffs cannot be taken into the United States.

I would strongly advise that students bring any spending money with them on a travel debit card as this is much safer and easier than carrying lots of money on their person, these can be obtained from any post office or travel agent.

Please ensure that your child is prepared for all weathers so they will need sun cream and waterproofs! Students will need a bag that they can use day to day during the trip (this could be the bag that they use for hand luggage).
