GCSE YEAR 11 GEOGRAPHY TRIP TO LEEDS – 20th NOVEMBER 2018

As part of your child's studies for GCSE Geography, it is a compulsory requirement that they undertake two pieces of fieldwork; the first one which they have already completed at the end of Year 10 (Arkengarthdale trip) and the second fieldtrip which will take place on **Tuesday, 20th November 2018**. The focus of this investigation will be the changes around the urban area of Leeds, and this will involve visits to several contrasting parts of the city.

The students will not be under the constant supervision of their teachers on the visit but have been told about the standards of behaviour we expect when they are representing the school. They will be allowed to work with a group of students from their class although they must not go away from this group on their own under any circumstances. It is essential that on the day, all students complete each task accurately, as the results will form a major part of their write-up back in class.

We will be departing Bedale High School at 9.00am and expect to return at approximately 4.30pm, therefore arrangements will need to be made to ensure that your child can return home outside school transport times. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and will not be required to wear school uniform. Sensible appropriate clothing, including waterproofs, and appropriate footwear is required as the weather can be unpredictable at this time of year!

The cost of the trip including transport and insurance will be £5. Please can payment and consent be made via Parentpay by **Tuesday, 13th November 2018**.
