Year 11 Pre-public exams – March 2019

I am writing to inform you that all students in Year 11 will begin their pre-public GCSE exams across most subjects in March 2019. The exams will begin on Monday 18th March 2019.

Please find attached a copy of the timetable, all other pre-public exams will take place the week beginning 25th March in scheduled lesson time.

All students are expected to be in school daily at their normal time and should be ready to line up for all examinations 10 minutes before the published start time.

It is important that students take these pre-public exams seriously, as this will be an opportunity to practice exam papers in full exam conditions, before their official exams begin in May 2019.

In order for the students to complete their exams, we are asking that they bring their own exam equipment with them. This should be a clear pencil case or small clear plastic bag with all stationery items such as **black pens** (all exams must be written in Black Ink) pencils, ruler, compasses and an eraser. Students should also ensure that they have a scientific calculator as this can be used in a number of exams such as Mathematics and Science, please refer to the Candidate Hand Book for additional exam information.
