

My Week Of Work

8th-12th June

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Overview

Normally in the summer term all year 10's would be getting ready for 'Work Ready Week' in school. Unfortunately due to the covid-19 situation this will not be able to go ahead as normal this year. However, as an alternative we are providing students the opportunity to take part in a remote/virtual careers week called 'My Week of Work' from **Monday 8th June – Friday 12th June**. Throughout the week students will have access to a series of different video lessons and Q and A sessions. By the end of the week it is hoped that the students will have a better understanding of jobs available within different industries, recruitment and applications, employability skills and much more!

The 'My Week of Work' programme includes 2 main features:

1. **The Oak National Academy** – virtual careers lessons with 20 sessions scheduled from Monday to Friday
2. **Learn Live interactive Q&A sessions** with a wide range of employers from Tuesday to Thursday with a session exploring 'Your Next Steps on Friday'.

It is not compulsory for students to participate in all the sessions. The timetables for each part of the programme are included in this information, please have a look at these and select sessions that you feel will be most beneficial. We would recommend that students participate in at least 2 OAK National Academy lesson and at least 1 Learn Live session, however the more you are able to participate in the better.

At the start of the week there will be a 'reflection task' assigned to students on Show My Homework. At the end of the week we would like all students to complete this to encourage them to reflect on what they have learnt from the sessions they have participated in and get them to begin thinking about their next steps after BHS.

Questions?

Q: What if there is a learn live session I want to attend on at the same time as an OAK session I would like to attend?

A: If a pupil doesn't know whether to choose between Learn Live and an OAK session running at the same time, they should choose Learn Live as the employers are available at this specific time. The Oak sessions will be published for the whole week and can be accessed at any time.

Q: Do I have to attend all the sessions?

A: Whilst it is not compulsory to attend every session in the week, we would advise that you take part in as many as you can as it will be very beneficial for you when it comes to deciding on your next steps after school. We advise that every student takes part in a minimum of 2 OAK sessions and 1 Learn Live session throughout the week.

Q: Do I need to register beforehand?

A: For the OAK National Academy virtual lessons you do not need to register, click <https://www.thenational.academy/online-classroom/year-10#schedule> to access the lessons throughout the week. However, you do need to register for the Learn Live sessions – this can be done at any time via <https://learnliveuk.com/my-week-of-work/>

Q: Do I need to hand in any work as part of this week?

A: At the start of the week there will be a reflection task uploaded to Show My Homework that we would like all students to complete by the end of the week (regardless of how many sessions you have attended).

Q: What if I lose this information? How will I then be able to access the sessions?

A: Each day next week Miss Temple will upload the timetable of sessions available to you on show my homework, so you can also access them via that.
