There has been a lot of talk in the media over the last week or so regarding what will happen with the GCSE exams in the summer. As it stands, the government are sticking to their line that there will be a full exam season of externally run GCSE exams. Our preparation in school continues, largely as normal, with 2 sets of practice exams (Pre-Public Exams that are called PPEs). Please read the attached letters from Mr Gill and Miss Riley-Fox that give you the information you need about these exams and you will also see the exam timetable. One of the key things to take on board is that Year 11s should be starting to revise for these exams now - this 'little and often' approach really pays off in terms of keeping things at a well-planned, more stress-free level. The other thing we are urging the Year 11s to be aware of is that the government's stance could change...and we may yet find ourselves in a situation where we have to use the PPE results as substitute grades for their actual results. Therefore, it is more important than ever that they take these PPEs seriously.
