## Changes to Autumn Term Start Dates and Update on Covid Testing

Shortly after the publication of last week's newsletter, the Department for Education have confirmed that school will need to administer Covid tests to all consenting students at the start of the Autumn term in September. They have been quick to acknowledge the huge challenge that this presents for schools, and they have suggested that schools stagger the return of students to allow for the testing to take place.

The good news is that we have done this before (after the Christmas holiday), and Miss Riley-Fox (together with a fantastic team of parents, volunteers and staff) did a brilliant job with it, ensuring that the testing was as smooth and hassle-free as possible. She has agreed to take this on again for the Autumn term - so we know that your children are in good hands! However, this does mean that we have had to change our plans for the start of term. We are asked to test the students twice, but this has to be 3 to 5 days apart. Our challenge is having to fit in 2 staff training days, 2 Covid testing days split 3 to 5 days apart, and some time for Year 7 transition (since they have had to miss their transition week in school this summer). Unfortunately, we have had to postpone two other events next week: the Year 10 Duke of Edinburgh Expedition (parents have been sent a separate email about this), and the Year 5 concert. Both events are being rearranged for the autumn term - not permanently cancelled. We are very conscious that the number of positive cases is rising rapidly in our area, and some schools around us have already closed as a result of this, or have several year groups remote learning. I just feel it would be very irresponsible and reckless for us to do anything that could make this situation even worse when we are so close to the holidays.

The Year 11 Prom is slightly different in that we can do this without these students coming into school, and it only requires a small number of staff (who will socially distance from each other and students at all times). Students will also need to provide evidence of a recent negative lateral flow test before they are allowed to attend.

#### **New Year 7s – Virtual Transition Week**

We would all have been much happier if we had been able to welcome our new Year 7s in person, but I have to say that this week's virtual transition has been a real success. Thank-you so much to Miss Bradbury for all the hard work and organisation she has put into this, and also to the staff and students who were delivering sessions. But the biggest thank-you of all goes to the Year 6 students and their teachers for engaging so well with the sessions!

My personal highlight of the week was when we did a live, unscripted Q/A session with 4 of our current Year 7s asking me questions in front of the Year 6 virtual audience. I was not allowed to see the questions in advance, and it's fair to say they threw in a few curve-balls! 30 mins into the session we had already spoken about a diverse range of topics: our core values, why I became a headteacher, why carrot cake is wrong, whether I'd prefer to be able to fly or transport myself anywhere, the best/worst things about BHS and why Leeds are the best football team to support!

The questions from the Year 6 students were brilliant and our students did a fabulous job of answering many of them.

### **Changes to Contact Tracing** from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July



Please can I ask that parents carefully read the attached letter from the Department for Education. It sets out significant changes that will come into effect from Monday, in relation to how the tracing of positive Covid contacts will work in schools. The main change is that schools will no longer be responsible for tracking the contacts of a positive case. NHS Test and Trace will work with you to do this. You may also find this electronic leaflet useful:

#### **Contact Tracing Changes**

The letter also outlines the changes that will come into effect on 16<sup>th</sup> August in relation to self-isolation.

#### **Immunisations** Catch-up

If a student has missed any of their routine immunisations (HPV and School Leaver Boosters) then they should contact The Childhood student can attend. If not then it is the parent carer's responsibility to book an appointment with their own doctor or nurse at their GP
