Covid Update

Covid Testing After Christmas

The government have once again asked schools to carry out 1 Covid test on students when they return to school after the Christmas holiday, to help reduce the potential spread of Covid especially with the new variant on the increase. Please see the attached letter that went out to all parents earlier this week. Parents need to give consent for their child to be tested, (if they wish for school to test them on their return) and the form must be completed by the 6th December. Please note that all students return to school on Weds 5th January - whether they are being tested or not. Those who do wish to be tested will be called out of lessons but this will be planned in a way that minimises disruption to teaching.

Covid Vaccinations (repeated from last week's issue)

We have finally received an update from the School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) who have confirmed that they will be back in school on Monday 13th December. Their focus on this visit will be offering the Covid vaccination to students in Years 7-9 whose parents have consented. They have said that there is the possibility of them trying to administer jabs to some of the Year 10 and Year 11 students who missed out last time but this will depend on how quickly they get through the other students. Unfortunately, they require new consent from those wishing to have the jab so that a new list can be created. Nurses are aware that some students may have been for their Covid jab since they last visited school and so the previous list will now be out of date. A new consent form has been emailed out this week. Please ensure you complete the form if you wish for your child to be vaccinated.

Covid Measures in school

Last weekend, following the emergence of the Omicron variant of Covid, the government asked all schools to reinstate the wearing of face-coverings in communal areas. Students have been much better in their response to these messages this week. Thank you for your support in this. Please also remind them that they must wear a face covering on school or public transport too.
