Covid Update

Face-Coverings

The latest government guidance is that students and staff no longer need to wear face-coverings in lessons, or in communal areas in school. Students should continue to wear them on buses if it is particularly busy, or if the driver asks them to. We will continue to review the situation in school and reserve the right to reinstate face-coverings if case numbers rise significantly. In the interim period, both staff and students may still choose to wear them in school.

Update on Vaccination Programme for 12-15 Year Olds

We are still waiting to hear from the School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) to confirm when they will be back in school to offer vaccinations. Self-Isolation

People who are self-isolating with COVID-19 can reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with an LFD test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a

temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace.

If the result of either test is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.


Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10-day period of self-isolation.
