## Covid Update

### Changes to Covid Protocols in School

Parents will no doubt be aware that the government announced changes to the in-school protocols around Covid this week. From yesterday, students are no longer required to wear face-coverings in lessons. Any students or staff who wish to continue wearing them may do so. From Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> January, students will not be required to wear masks in communal areas, but up to that date they will remain in place. Other in-school measures such as sanitising hands and the one-way system will also remain in place and we will keep our measures under review as we move forwards. Students should continue to wear face-coverings on buses for the moment.

### Update on Vaccination Programme for 12-15 Year Olds

We await to hear from the School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) to confirm when they will be back in school to offer vaccinations. Parents can book out-of-school vaccinations for your child, should you choose to do so. The link for further information on this is here: [NHS Vaccinations](#)

### Self-Isolation

People who are self-isolating with COVID-19 have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with an LFD test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace.

If the result of either test is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10-day period of self-isolation.

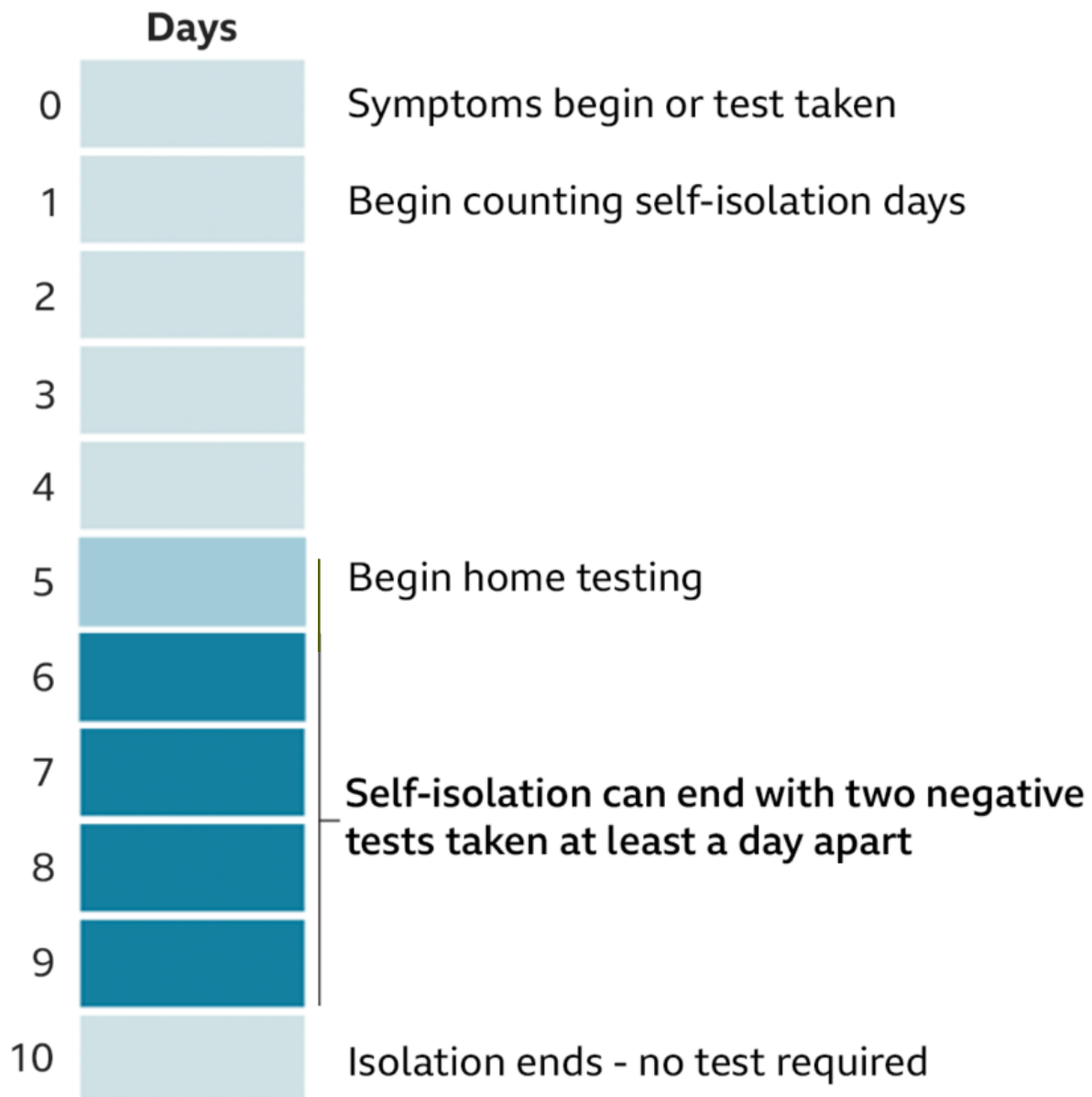

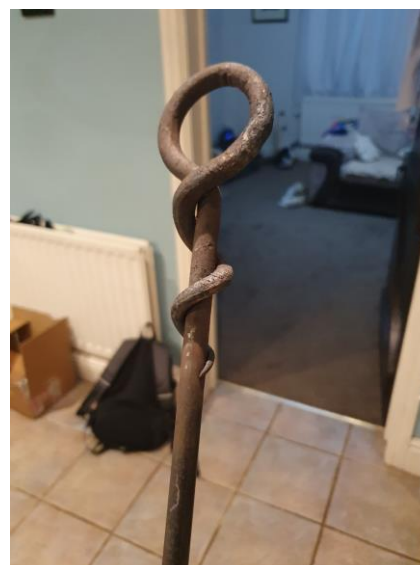
## Well Done Isabella

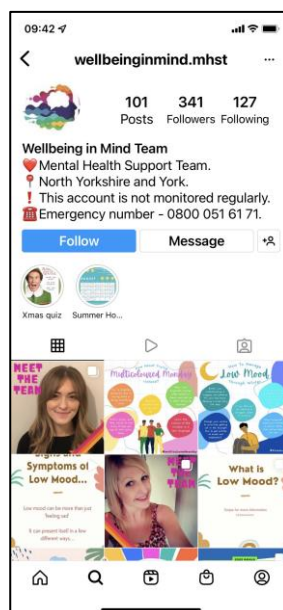
## Forthcoming Immunisations
