### **Year 11 Virtual Parent Evening**

This event takes place on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> January and in light of the current Covid situation, it will now be held virtually with video call appointments replacing the face to face appointments in school. We have signed up with SchoolCloud for this - many schools in the area use them for these events.

I have written to all Yr 11 parents this week with instructions on how to log on and how to make appointments for your son or daughter. Both of these documents are attached with today's newsletter. It is very straightforward, so please do not be put off if you are a tech-phobe like me!

If you wish for another parent who lives in a different location to be part of your video appointment, you can add them to the call by following these instructions:

Video: Parents - invite another parent/guardian to join your appointments - SchoolCloud Parents Evening (parentseveningsystem.co.uk)

Another thing to be aware of is that we have to schedule the appointments to strict time slots. To enable teachers to get through as many as possible, we have limited the appointments to 5 mins (the same as you would get at a face to face parent evening in most cases). But I ask parents to remember that the call will abruptly terminate once the 5 mins have run out - so please keep an eye on the countdown on screen. I have attended a virtual parent evening for my own children - and it's easy to lose track of time. Please do not think that staff are being rude when it suddenly ends after 5 mins - there is no option to delay it or extend the times as it impacts on the following parent's appointment.

The usual etiquette to video calls applies - if you would prefer to have your camera off that is fine. We also ask that, where possible, your child attends the call with you. They will have received their PPE exam grades earlier in the day and it is important that they are part of the discussion with their teachers.

# **Covid Update**



Over Christmas, the guidance for schools was updated by the Department for Education. Please see the summary below for the key information around protocols in school.

#### Covid Testing

Students have been issued with more Covid testing kits this week. Please remember to keep testing them <u>twice a week</u> and to report a positive test to school immediately. From Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> January, anyone in England who receives a positive lateral flow test result should report their result on gov.uk and must self-isolate immediately, but will not need to take a follow-up PCR test.

#### Tracing Contacts and Isolation

Adults who are fully vaccinated and all children and young people aged between 5 and 18 years and 6 months identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 are strongly advised to take a lateral flow test every day for 7 days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they develop symptoms or have a positive test result. Daily testing of close contacts applies to all contacts who are:

- fully vaccinated adults people who have had 2 doses of an approved vaccine
- all children and young people aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, regardless of their vaccination status
- people who are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons
- people taking part, or have taken part, in an approved clinical trial for a COVID-19 Vaccine

The self-isolation advice for people with coronavirus (COVID-19) has changed. It is now possible to end self-isolation after 7 days, following 2 negative LFD tests taken 24 hours apart. The first LFD test should not be taken before the sixth day. But if a high temperature remains, or if you have not been able to take lateral flow tests, the full 10 days must be completed. Please ensure you contact school on day 7 to confirm if your child is able to return or not from day 8.

#### Face Coverings

Students must now wear face-coverings in lessons, on corridors and on buses and public transport (unless they are exempt). The DfE are reviewing this on 26<sup>th</sup> January to see whether the masks in classrooms needs to continue or not.

#### Hand-Sanitising

Students will continue to use sanitiser on entry to each lesson, and on entry to the dining hall for break and lunch.

#### Desk Cleaning

Staff are continuing to wipe down surfaces and desks in between lessons to reduce the chance of transmission

#### Other

Currently, we are able to continue with extra-curricular activities and there is no need to resort to year group bubbles. Some events may need to be adapted but we will strive to keep school as normal as possible for students.
