General Update

Punctuality Focus

We have now completed the first full week of our new punctuality procedures which will be trialled until half term. As I explained last week, this follows an external review which highlighted some aspects for improvement around attendance and punctuality. This led to our Be On Time, Every Time focus for this half term with all students, in an effort to reduce the number of students who arrive late in the morning, and to promote punctuality as a vital 'work-ready' habit that students need to value. The initial impact is encouraging, with the number of students arriving late to school significantly reduced over the last week. Thank you for your ongoing support with this.

Covid

A couple of cases have appeared in school again this week (I am one of them - writing this in our spare room at home, trying to avoid passing it on to my son who is about to start his GCSEs!). A reminder that if anyone has symptoms of a respiratory infection, such as COVID-19, and they have a high temperature or do not feel well enough to go to school, they are advised to try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people. If your child tests positive for Covid, they need to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days after the day they took the test. If after 3 days, they feel well and do not have a high temperature then they can return to school.

PTA Support

In September, we will welcome our biggest year group of new Year 7 students for many years (nearly a 40% increase on our current year groups). This is testament to the school's ongoing improvements and outreach work within the community and beyond. Mrs Woodward heads up a lot of this work, and created the new PTA parent support group to support with functions and events. They have been amazing, but we would still love to attract more helpers who are willing to be part of this group.
