
# **Bobby's Charity Hair Chop**

Mr Bielby Writes: For the last 3 Monday afternoons, I have taken 14 x Yr 10 students over to the Harrogate Indoor Climbing Centre (Parthian) so they could gain experience at climbing as well as gaining a practical mark which could go towards their final grade. The students seemed to really enjoy the new environment and the challenges that they all faced. During the 3 weeks the students learned a number of new skills ranging from how to tie knots, belaying each other safely using different belay devices, to climbing different routes and bouldering (low level climbing without ropes). It was a pleasure to see our students support each other and rise to the new challenges, as well as come away with some really positive marks which will go towards their final practical marks.
