What happens at Careers Event?

The event is an interactive event designed to inspire young people, their teachers, and parents/carers about careers in the Healthcare Sector. This event will give students, teachers, and parent/carers the opportunity to try their hand at interactive workshops, to experience what it is like working in the sector, and most importantly to spend time with the Nurses, Allied Health Professionals, and Scientists working in the heart of our health care sector lives.

This is a lively but very carefully organised event whereby students will move in small groups through the interactive workshops

By highlighting different entry levels, including those for apprentices as well as graduates, we encourage young people of all abilities.

This carefully organised day:

- Helps young people to focus their thinking about school subject choices and to consider career paths in health.
- Changes their perceptions about working in Health & Care and the people who work in the sector.
- Gives some students confidence about their abilities they may not have found in the classroom.
- Increases teachers' knowledge about the Health and Care sector and provides plenty of ideas to enrich lessons and support CEIAG (Careers Education, Information, Advice, and Guidance).
- Builds new relationships between schools and employers.
- Makes companies aware of the hidden talent in the classroom.

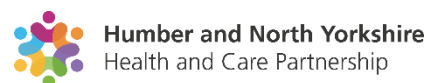
