I would like to say a huge thank-you to all of the RAF Leeming parents who turned up to the meeting on Tuesday evening to discuss current issues with the school bus service.

It was also great to have representation from the camp from Greg Horan, and from Proctors bus service - Andrew Fryatt.

In the meeting, I shared historic (and some recent) concerns about behaviour on this bus which has put the service at risk.

Parent were extremely supportive and contributed a number of suggestions as to how we might monitor this situation. Eventually we agreed to trial a seating plan based on allocating seat numbers. I sorted a plan yesterday - but unfortunately when I came to implement it - we discovered the seats had no numbers! I have contacted Proctors and, in the meantime, we will stick with year group seating and the message that students should report any issues on this service so that we can protect it for all of you.
